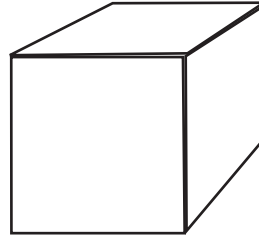
Value Scale:

Vary your pressure to get lighter or darker.



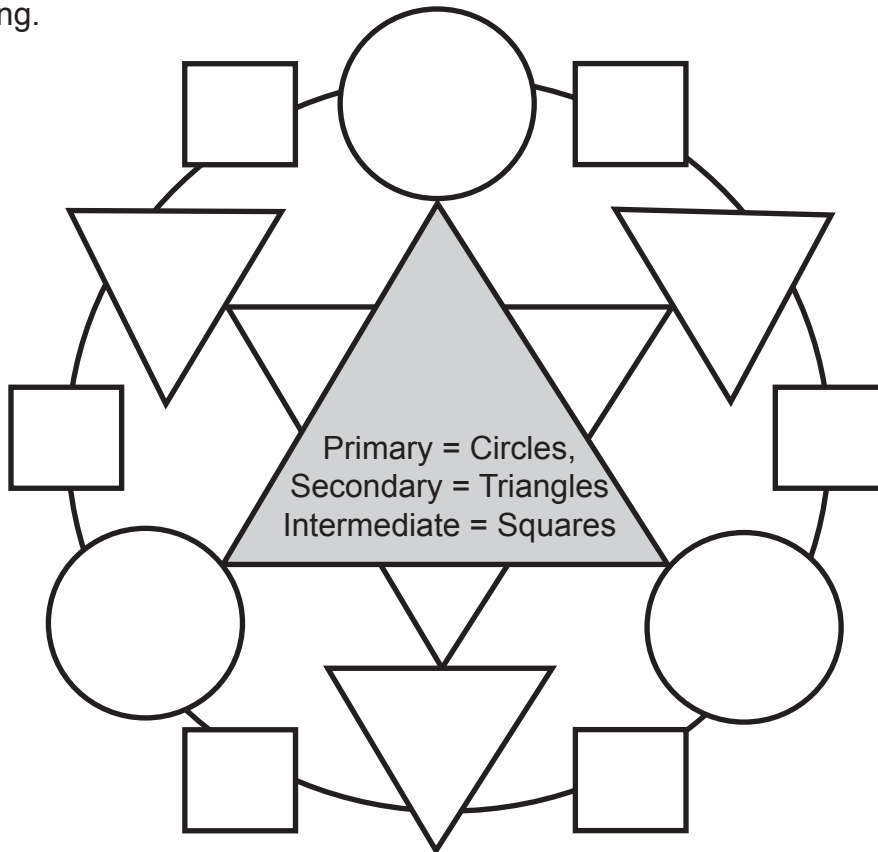
Illusion of form:

Monochromatic:

Choose one color and create five different values of the color.

Warm Colors:

Colors that contains red & yellow, & all the tints, tones, & shades of those colors.

Colors that contains at least 50% blue & all the tints, tones, & shades of those colors.
